SUBMISSIONS

- Application with abstract
- Abstract length maximum of 300 words
- Submit proposal via the ESP website, espnational.org
- Proposals will undergo blind reviewed by a panel of Extension Professionals.

The ESP Professional Development Committee is seeking proposals for scholarly presentations for our upcoming **webinar series**.

The committee invites proposals that:

- Apply to a broad cross section of ESP members
- Are learner-focused with clearly defined outcomes
- Are based upon a foundation of research, theory or practical application
- Showcase a collaborative and team effort in planning and delivery of project
- Reflect innovation and cutting edge content

Proposals will be submitted via the ESP website, espnational.org. Proposals require a 300-word (maximum) abstract. Abstracts will undergo a blind review process to select those to be presented. Scoring criteria details can be found on the ESP website.

Deadline for submission is February 1, 2017. Presenters will be notified after review. Webinars will be scheduled for a time between mid-March and early May, 2017.

Webinar Presentations

- Sessions will be up to 60 minutes in length. Presenters should include at least 10 minutes for questions and discussion within this time frame.
- A session may be a presentation, panel discussion or other appropriate methodology for a webinar presentation.
- Webinars will be recorded and made available to ESP membership.
- Presentation materials must be submitted to the ESP Professional Development Committee for posting on the website.
- Dates and times for webinars will be arranged directly with presenters once abstracts are selected for webinar series.
- An individual may be the lead presenter on one proposal submission.
 A person may be included as a co-presenter on one additional proposal.
